Licensee may not modify, improve, translate, reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, or

And you must show them these terms so they know their rights.

To protect each distributor, we want to make it very clear that there is no warranty for the free library. Whether this is true is especially significant if the work can be linked without the Library, or if the work is itself a library. The threshold for this to be true is not precisely defined by law.
